

Campsite Rules

We are very pleased that you are spending your valuable vacation time with us. To ensure that all guests feel comfortable and can enjoy a relaxing stay, we kindly ask you to observe the following guidelines:

1. Our pitches are numbered. Please remain within the boundaries of your assigned pitch. Your car should be parked directly on your pitch. If you require an additional parking space, our reception team will be happy to assist you.
2. Please be considerate of other guests. Radios, televisions, sound systems, or musical instruments should be used in a way that does not disturb anyone. Thank you for your understanding and consideration.
3. One vehicle or vehicle combination is permitted per pitch (1 caravan + 1 car, 1 motorhome, or 1 tent + 1 car). Unfortunately, additional vehicles cannot be parked directly on the pitch.
4. If the number of persons staying on your pitch changes, please inform reception briefly. Additional overnight guests must be registered.
5. Quiet hours are from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. and from 10:00 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. During these times, we kindly ask for special consideration. The barrier also remains closed during quiet hours.
6. Walking speed (max. 15 km/h) applies throughout the entire campsite to ensure that children in particular can move around safely.
7. Dogs are very welcome but must be kept on a leash throughout the campsite and may not be left unattended on the pitch. Dogs are not permitted at Lake Wolfgang or on the sunbathing lawn. Please walk your dog outside the campsite grounds.
8. Check-in: 1:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
9. Check-out: 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
10. Visitors are welcome after prior registration at reception. Further information can be found on the notice board.
11. Please separate your waste carefully and dispose of it in the designated containers. Bulky waste (e.g., parasols, loungers, chairs, etc.) cannot be disposed of on site.
12. Please note that valuables, equipment, and sports gear are not insured by the campsite operator. No liability can be accepted for damage or loss caused by third parties.
13. Children under 6 years of age may only enter the sanitary facilities when accompanied by an adult. Please help keep the facilities clean – they are not playgrounds. Parents are responsible for their children.
14. Boats and surfboards may not be moored to the swimming jetty or placed on the sunbathing lawn.
15. Fishing is not permitted at the campsite's private jetty or along the beach section. A valid fishing permit is required for fishing.
16. Washing vehicles (cars, caravans, motorhomes, etc.) is not permitted on the campsite.
17. Clotheslines may not be strung between trees or barriers.
18. Gas, electric, and designated low-smoke charcoal grills (e.g., LotusGrill) may be used on your pitch. Charcoal grills and open fires are not permitted for official safety reasons.
19. In the event of violations of these guidelines, we reserve the right to exercise our house rules.
